#### DATE AND VENUE

The 39<sup>th</sup> annual Southern African Transport Conference (SATC 2021), supported by the South African Department of Transport and the International Road Federation, will take place from Monday 5 July to Thursday 8 July 2021 at the CSIR International Convention Centre, Pretoria, South Africa.

#### OBJECTIVES

The conference theme is "SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION THROUGH ENABLING PARTNERSHIPS". The conference will engage all stakeholders involved in the transport sector on how to provide optimum, effective and efficient transportation solutions to improve service delivery to better respond as a sector, to the needs of all users of our transport systems.

The conference provides a platform for national and international dialogues on transport as an enabler of socio-economic development. It also serves as a forum for discussion and information exchange on the implementation of transport policy, strategy and technology applications for all aspects and modes of transportation. Better cooperation between and engagement of all public and private sector stakeholders will be one of the key issues that will be debated and for which solutions will be sought and action plans formulated.

# ATTENDANCE

Everyone in any way connected with transport is invited. This conference will be of particular interest to funding agencies, municipal, provincial and national government authorities, parastatals, policy- and decision-makers, academics, researchers, students and professionals active in the planning, construction, manufacturing, logistics, operation and safety of passenger and freight transport, road traffic, rail, maritime and aviation. End-users will also find the conference of interest. A special session will be arranged to discuss and debate critical policy issues related to the theme of the conference.

It is important that the following information is included on the first page of the paper:

- Title of the paper.
- Name(s) of author and co-author(s).
- The corresponding author's title, initials and name, organisation and postal address, phone and e-mail details.
- If presenting/first author is up to 35 years of age, please indicate in order to qualify for the Young Professional Award.
- A 200-word abstract.

Please note that only authors who can comply with the following deadlines and undertake to present their papers at the conference should submit abstracts. The refereeing procedure will be done electronically. Papers should conform to the SATC standards and requirements.

Acceptance of papers will be on the understanding that the author (or a co-author) will attend the conference as a fee-paying delegate. Authors are responsible for their own registration, travel and subsistence costs.

#### AWARDS

There are awards for the:

- BEST PEER REVIEWED PAPER all authors qualify Prize: R16 000
- BEST PRACTICAL PAPER all authors qualify Prize: R16 000
- BEST PEER REVIEWED PAPER BY A YOUNG PROFESSIONAL sponsored by the SA Institution of Civil Engineering (SAICE) - authors up to the age of 35 qualify (authors who meet this criterion should notify the organisers).

To be eligible for the awards, papers need to go through the full review process and meet the deadline dates.

#### STUDENT ESSAY COMPETITION

The essay competition is open to all registered students (undergraduate as well as postgraduate) at tertiary institutions. The competition is held within the institutions and each institution will select its two winners. An essay is an individual attempt and can only have one author.

Students need to prepare a five-page essay according to the conference paper format on "SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION THROUGH ENABLING PARTNERSHIPS", providing innovative solutions for the conference theme. Institutions must submit the winning entries by 10 May 2021 so that they may be included on the SATC 2021 USB. Winning students and their lecturer will receive a complimentary registration for SATC 2021. Transport to Pretoria and accommodation will also be sponsored.

#### BURSARIES

SATC will offer two prestigious bursaries per year at R170 000, per bursary tax free for fulltime South African or SADC students working on their M or D research component in transportation. The Board has also instituted a bursary for a deserving South African or SADC student studying for an undergraduate qualification involving transport to cover tuition, books and accommodation. Closing date for applications is 15 December 2020. Please visit the SATC website for more information and application form.

#### **EXHIBITION AND PROMOTIONAL OPPORTUNITIES**

An exhibition – a showcase for all related industries – will be held in conjunction with the conference. Exhibition space  $(3m \times 3m)$  is available on a first come, first served basis. #### FEES

Fees will be determined nearer to the date of the Conference. However, it is expected that an enrolment fee of approximately R2 500 per day will be applicable.

#### TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation will be recommended at suitable hotels in Pretoria. Courtesy transport will be provided daily between the CSIR International Convention Centre and the appointed hotels. More details will be included in the final announcement.
